



2009-2010 Extreme Club Program

There's none of us in our community that are not affected by this economy. Some unfortunately are effected far more than others. While our mission is to support and develop the youth in our community to play soccer, we realize that soccer is an additional cost and burden to families that must be prioritized and put into perspective for each of us.

With that being said, we made efforts to limit the cost to play in a quality competitive travel soccer program without sacrificing quality of content. We are further trying to support families and mitigate additional cost associated with Travel Soccer by:

- Restricting tournament participation to local tournaments that do not require an overnight stay. Exceptions will be made for teams participating in State Cup and State Friendly events as well as teams participating in invitation only showcase tournaments. Other teams wishing to travel will only be allowed when Coaches and Club feels that it is necessary for the teams development and ALL parents on the team agree.
- Payment options will be available at Registration that extend payments evenly over a 10 month period.

Please note: CW3 is the **ONLY** Club that openly provides the cost to play before showing up to a tryout session. We are 25% more economical than our neighboring competitive clubs. Please continue reading for cost details. There are no other hidden fees to play.

The 2009-2010 Program offering includes:

- Team Pre-season Training Camp
- Fall League Play
- Goal Keeper Training (fall and spring)
- Indoor non-boarded Play (two winter sessions at **Total Sports**)
- Indoor Training Sessions (estimated 16 indoor sessions) Priority will be given to rent as much time as possible from **Total Sports** in Wixom
- Spring League Play
- One Tournament
- Price include 2 each Training Shirts
- Futsal League – Nov thru Dec, \$30 add'l fee through partnership with Walled Lake Schools
- Optional Skills Training Available – minimal additional cost (fall & spring)
- All coaching fees
 - * U15 and older teams will offer the same basic program but will be modified appropriately to accommodate and enhance players high school playing experience. Detailed differences will be available at try-outs which may include participating in the State Cup and/or participating in Invitation only Showcase Tournaments for teams that qualify.

Supporting CW3 House and Rec. Travel Programs

While not a specified benefit to Club members, Jim Lemly is now assigned to support coaches and players in our House and Rec Travel Programs. Jim will be conducting weekly clinics for U6 and U8 players and teams throughout the fall and spring of this next year as well as support coaches with developmental questions and provide active support to all house coaches and teams.

Standardization and Professional Development

A developmental curriculum will be implemented this year that will assist coaches in ensuring that our players are all introduced and trained on specific soccer skills and tactics at the appropriate ages. Likewise all coaches will be mentored, evaluated and professionally developed by our MSYSA and US Youth Soccer professionally trained staff.

Individual Training Resources

With such a qualified array of talented coaches and an infrastructure to manage them, the Club will be able to facilitate individual training to those wishing to seek more development opportunities for their children. We will offer weekly optional skills training for a modest additional charge for those interested.

Community Involvement

CW3 has heavily invested and improved our relationships with our townships and municipalities inside our community. We have worked very hard to successfully strengthen our relationship with Walled Lake Community Education and our School District. We deeply value and appreciate our relationship with Walled Lake Community Education and are always looking at ways to further support our District like partnering with them to host a Futsal League this next winter.

We are also fully committed to the communities of Wixom, Wolverine Lake, Walled Lake, West Bloomfield, White Lake, and Commerce. We actively participate in Parks and Recreation Meetings within our community and we offer our support to all of their success and future growth.
