



NEW! U9 Academy Rec Travel Program

Cost effective optional program between CW3 house and “Select Travel Soccer”. The U9 Academy Rec Travel Program offers a more structured program designed by professionally licensed soccer coaches (trainers) that will assist our Volunteer coaches in the training / development of each team. Specifics include:

1. Transitional program between CW3 House and “Select Travel Soccer” with professionally licensed trainers while still having parent coaches to minimize costs.
2. U9 Academy Rec Travel teams will still be formed by elementary school or combining players from close by elementary schools. Players will not be placed or selected on teams via a tryout or other recruiting or selection process.
3. Program availability is limited and reserved on a first-come, first-serve basis.
4. Each team will receive a weekly training session that focuses on passing, receiving, shooting, and game situations (tactical) in addition to ball control and foot skills.
5. The trainer will conduct a minimum of 8 practices during the season (1/wk).
6. The volunteer coach is the Head Coach. Head Coaches may schedule a second practice each week (recommended at U9). Head Coaches will coach the team during all games.
7. The trainer will assist the coach at two games.
8. Trainers will provide parents with an evaluation of their player once per season.
9. Teams will play in WSSL Recreation Travel League. Parents should expect to play 4 home games at CW3 fields and 4 away games. Away games may be in a 20 mile radius from the Novi Civic Center.
10. Player will have a home and away jersey that is the same as our Rec Travel Teams. Uniform kit is an additional \$35 but may be used for more than one season or even multiple years.
11. Game format will be 6v6 and include goalkeepers (players will be introduced to this position for the first time). Players will be coached from the sidelines per U10 rules of play.
12. All training session with team Trainer will be held at centrally located Bicentennial Park (Commerce Township old offices off of Fisher Rd). Bicentennial Part will be exclusively reserved for the Academy at set times.
13. Training session may start as early as 5:30pm and will move towards 5:00 as daylight declines in the late fall season. Teams may be assigned either a 5:30 or 6:30 practice time slot.
